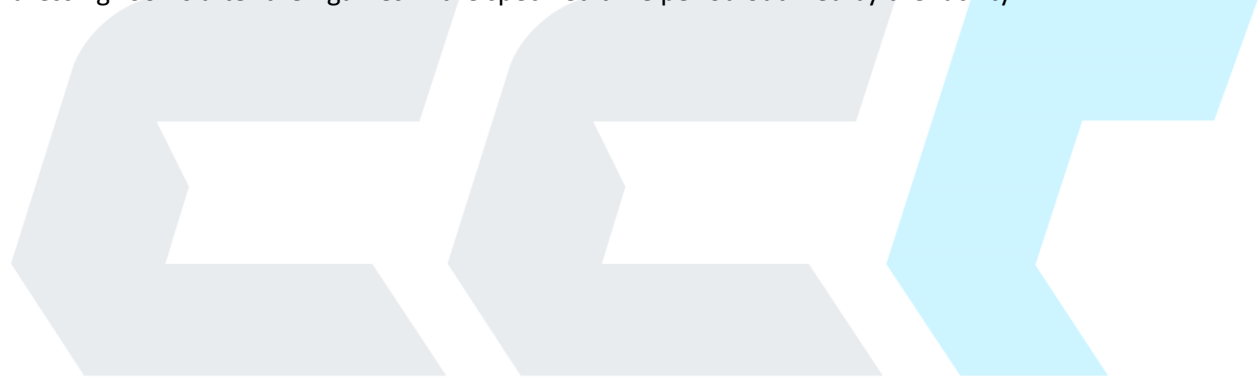


ALCOHOL, CONTAINERS & SMOKING POLICIES

As of May 1st, 2013 all Canlan Ice Sports owned and operated facilities have adopted a ZERO tolerance policy on Alcohol consumption and transport as well as Smoking in unlicensed areas of our facilities. This includes, but not limited to, lobbies, parking lots, arena playing surfaces, surrounding areas, and dressing rooms. Any player/team found consuming or carrying alcoholic beverages or smoking in non-designated areas will receive a warning letter (1st offence) outlining the policy and expectations moving forward. A second offence by the same team/player will result in a \$500 refundable performance bond that will be taken immediately. This will be returned in full at the conclusion of the season if no further incidents arise. If a 3rd offence occurs, the \$500 bond will not be returned and the team/player will be suspended indefinitely from participation and must apply for reinstatement at a later date. No refunds will be issued.

We remind all members that the consumption of alcohol in unlicensed locations and smoking indoors is against the law and that serious liability issues may arise from this action. Teams are to be out of the dressing rooms after their games in the specified time period outlined by the facility.
